

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF A TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE AT THE INTERSECTION OF BRECKSVILLE AND EVERETT ROADS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor and Director of Finance be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the County of Summit for the replacement of a traffic control device at the intersection of Brecksville Road and Everett Road, a copy of which agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein fully as if by reference.

SECTION 2: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason that the traffic control device must be erected as promptly as possible for traffic safety and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
