A RESOLUTION TO COMMEND THOMAS S. FISHER ON THE OCCASION OF HIS RETIREMENT AS CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: THOMAS S. FISHER was appointed as Chief Constable of Richfield Township on January 1, 1962 and served with the Summit County Sheriff's Department in that position for more than five years, and

WHEREAS: THOMAS S. FISHER was appointed as the first Chief of Police of the Village of Richfield on July 18, 1967, and

WHEREAS: THOMAS S. FISHER was instrumental in the formation of the first Police Department in the Village of Richfield on January 1, 1970, and

WHEREAS: THOMAS S. FISHER has served Richfield Village and Richfield Township for twenty-five years and now chooses to retire from his position effective January 15, 1988.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT

SECTION 1: The Mayor and Council of the Village of Richfield recognize the long and outstanding public service of THOMAS S. FISHER to this Village and its residents for the past twenty-five years, and

SECTION 2: The Mayor and Council express appreciation to THOMAS S. FISHER and extend to him all best wishes for his continued success.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to provide a timely written memorial of service and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
