A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE AND FOR THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO SELL AT BID PRICES CERTAIN MUNICIPALLY-OWNED PROPERTY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village has accumulated various items of surplus property which this Council feels should be sold in the best interests of the Village.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Director of Public Service be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for sale various items of surplus Village property, a list of which items has been prepared by the Director of Public Service and is attached to this Resolution as Exhibit "A" and that the Mayor and Director of Finance be, and they hereby are, authorized to sell the various items of surplus property listed on Exhibit "A" at bid prices.

SECTION 2: This Resolution *(See Below) which is in force and effect until the earliest date provided by law.
