

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO PURCHASE A NEW ENGINE FOR THE HYDROCRUISER FROM GREAT LAKES ENERGY SYSTEMS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Village 1973 Hydrocruiser is in need of immediate repair; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has informed Council that a new #3-53 Detroit Diesel Engine is immediately available from Great Lakes Energy Systems; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has informed Council that the quoted price is fair and reasonable; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing circumstances constitute a real and present emergency within the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 735.051;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, State of Ohio, two-thirds of the members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Director of Finance be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to purchase a new #3-53 Detroit Diesel Engine from Great Lakes Energy Systems in an amount currently estimated not to exceed \$7,000 on an emergency basis without the necessity of formal bidding and advertisement.

Section 2: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to provide necessary repairs for Village equipment and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
