

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO AGREE TO NEW RATES WITH SUMMIT COUNTY FOR THE TRAFFIC LINE STRIPER CONTRACT. *AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY*

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to agree to new rates submitted by Summit County for the use of a Traffic Line Striper pursuant to the Village's contract with Summit ~~Co~~ County as authorized by Ordinance 64-1981.

Section 2: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 3: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to provide necessary Traffic Lines for the Village streets and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
