

AN ORDINANCE TO CONCUR IN THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION AND TO ACCEPT THE DEDICATION OF THE EXTENSION OF TIMBERWOOD TRAIL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, Ohio:

Section 1: The plat of Timberwood Trail, Village of Richfield, being part of Original Lot 11 and 12, formerly Richfield Township containing an area of 0.175 acres and bearing a date of May, 1988, shall be and the same is approved and accepted, and the dedication to public use of the streets thereon shown shall be and hereby is accepted and confirmed.

Section 2: The recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission with respect to such acceptance and confirmation is approved.

Section 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to provide public use of roadways and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
