

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE MAYOR AND THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT, OR A SERIES OF AGREEMENTS, WITH A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR SUBDIVISIONS FOR THE USE OF THE PISTOL RANGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, Ohio:

- Section 1: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with any separate political subdivision for the use of the Pistol Firing Range and to receive and receipt for the charges for such use.
- Section 2: The form of the contract, now on file in the office of the Director of Public Service, is approved and the form of such contract may be used from time to time and with the several political subdivisions without separate legislative authority therefore.
- Section 3: Such rules and regulations together with amendments thereto which the Mayor finds necessary and appropriate for the safe and efficient operation and conduct of the Pistol Range shall be applicable to the contract.
- Section 4: Ordinance 25-1985 and Ordinance 28-1985 are hereby repealed.
- Section 5: The Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to promote safety in firearms and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.

AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made and entered into between the Village of Richfield, Ohio (Village) and the _____ of _____ (Subdivision) with respect to the use of and payment for the Pistol Practice Range owned by the Village.

The parties agree as follows:

- (1) The Subdivision may use the Police Pistol Firing Range owned by the Village on the terms and conditions of this Agreement and upon the terms and conditions of the rules and regulations promulgated by the Mayor.
- (2) The subdivision shall, within 30 days after such use, pay to the Village the sum of Forty (\$40.00) dollars for each hour, or part thereof, of use. The Director of Finance shall provide appropriate billing documents to the subdivisions so as to allow the subdivision sufficient time to pay for such use.
- (3) The Bureau of Criminal Investigation of the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Ohio shall be exempt from the obligation to pay set forth in Paragraph 2 hereof but shall otherwise be subject to all the rules and regulations relating to the use of the range.
