

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE DIRECTOR OF LAW TO NEGOTIATE FOR THE ACQUISITION OF EASEMENTS, FOR THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ACCEPT THE EASEMENTS, TO PAY THE COSTS THEREOF AND TO OTHERWISE DO ALL THINGS NECESSARY TO ACQUIRE EASEMENTS FOR SEWER PURPOSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The Director of Law is authorized and directed to negotiate for grants of certain easements to this Village so as to allow this Village to install and maintain sewer facilities and equipment in connection with the sewer improvements now planned by this Village.

Section 2: The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed to receive on behalf of the Village those documents of easement and to make a public record thereof.

Section 3: The Director of Law is authorized and directed to do all those things necessary and appropriate, including obtaining real estate title information, to acquire easements by negotiation, but not to institute proceedings in eminent domain.

Section 4: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to acquire required easements and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
