

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION (C) OF SECTION 521.08 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO INCREASE THE PENALTY FROM A MISDEMEANOR OF THE FOURTH DEGREE TO A MISDEMEANOR OF THE THIRD DEGREE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: Section 521.08 of the Codified Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

521.08 LITTERING AND DEPOSIT OF GARBAGE, RUBBISH, JUNK, ETC.

(a) No person shall, without lawful authority, place or dispose of in any manner, upon any public property or upon the premises of another, any paper, trash, garbage, waste, rubbish, refuse, junk or any substance or material which is or may become noxious, offensive, injurious or dangerous to the public health, comfort or safety.

(b) No person shall cause or allow trash, garbage, waste, rubbish, refuse or any other noxious or offensive materials or substances to be collected or remain in any place to the damage or prejudice of others or of the public, or unlawfully obstruct, impede, divert, corrupt or render unwholesome or impure, any natural watercourse.

(c) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree.

Section 2: Existing Section 521.08 of the Codified Ordinances is hereby repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to increase the penalty and provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the

members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
