

RESOLUTION 58-1987

A RESOLUTION TO COMMEND E. JUNE FEIBER ON THE OCCASION OF THE END OF HER TERM AS MAYOR OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, E. June Feiber was first elected to the office of Mayor of the Village of Richfield for a term of four years beginning Jan. 1, 1980 and

WHEREAS, she was re-elected to a second term ending December 31, 1987 and pursuant to Article III, Section 3.01 of the Charter of the Village, she will have served this Village as Mayor for the maximum consecutive number of elected terms allowed by law and

WHEREAS, from July 1967 to December 1979 she, being the first woman elected to Council, served this Village as a member of council and was elected by her colleagues as President for a nine year period from 1971 and including 1979 and

WHEREAS, in addition to her faithful attendance at and active participation in the hundreds of meetings of the Boards and Commissions held and conducted from the time of her first being involved in the conduct of the affairs of this government, she has promoted and been successful in urging general public policy issues exemplified by the Richfield library, fire and medical services, parks and recreation, services for the elderly and road improvements and

WHEREAS, she has been particularly and specially involved in the construction and planning of water line and sewer line improvements, both of which will serve as lasting tributes to her persuasiveness and ability as an administrator of municipal public affairs and

WHEREAS, E. June Feiber, in addition to and not in limitation of all of the foregoing, has been an outstanding public servant and has set an example and standard for the best in the tradition of public service;

Now THEREFORE Be It RESOLVED by all of the members of the Council of the Village of Richfield, in public session, called specially this 15th day of December, 1987:

- Section 1: The Council expresses its appreciation to E. June Feiber for her long and outstanding public service to the Village of Richfield and to the citizens thereof and extends to her all of our best wishes for her continued success.
- Section 2: The Clerk is instructed to order, provide and deliver to E. June Feiber, in printed form or in form otherwise suitable to the occasion of the end of her terms as Mayor ending December 31, 1987, a certified copy of this Resolution and to otherwise spread upon the records of this Council the contents of this Resolution 55-1987.
- Section 3: In the event the Mayor does not sign or return this Resolution within a period of ten (10) days from the passage hereof, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force pursuant to the provisions of Article III Section 3.03 (c) of the Charter of the Village of Richfield.
- Section 4: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to memorialize the events described herein and provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor or as set forth in Section 3 hereof; otherwise it shall take effect and be in

force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
