

A RESOLUTION TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE QUARTER ENDING MARCH 31, 1986.

Section 1:	Be It Resolved by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio, that to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of said Village of Richfield during the quarter ending March 31, 1986, the following sums be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows: viz,	
Section 2:	That there be appropriated from the General Fund:	\$200,000.00
Section 3:	That there be appropriated from the Street Construction, Maintenance and Repair Fund (auto license and gasoline tax)	75,000.00
Section 4:	That there be appropriated from the State Highway Improvement Fund (7-1/2% of auto license and gasoline tax)	3,000.00
Section 5:	That there be appropriated from the Cemetery Fund:	2,000.00
Section 6:	That there be appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund:	40,000.00
Section 7:	That there be appropriated from the Parks and Recreation Fund:	10,000.00
Section 8:	That there be appropriated from the Income Tax Fund:	8,000.00
Section 9:	That there be appropriated from the Federal Revenue Sharing Fund:	10,000.00
Section 10:	That there be appropriated from the Sanitary Sewer Fund:	17,000.00
Section 11:	That there be appropriated from the Library Operating Fund:	3,000.00
Section 12:	That there be appropriated from the Water Revenue Fund:	<u>62,000.00</u>
	Total All Appropriations	<u>\$430,000.00</u>

Section 13: The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the Village for payment from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefor, approved by the board or officers authorized by Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance.
