

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT A FIRE PREVENTION CODE, KNOWN AS THE BOCA BASIC NATIONAL FIRE PREVENTION CODE, 1984, AND TO REPEAL ORDINANCE 57-1973.

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield,

Ohio:

Section 1: This Ordinance is a technical Ordinance and is adopted pursuant to R. C. Section 731.231.

Section 2: There is hereby adopted as the Fire Prevention Code the following technical codes, to-wit:
The BOCA Basic/National Fire Prevention Code, 6th Edition, 1984 as published by Building Officials and Code Administrators International, Inc., and in addition thereto Code 101 of the (N.F.I.P.A.) National Fire Prevention Code known as the Life safety code and insert in section F-100.1 of BOCA Code the name Village of Richfield

Section 3: The technical codes referred to herein are for the purpose of prescribing regulations consistent with recognized good practice for the safeguarding of life and property from the hazards of fire and explosion.

Section 4: Complete copies of the technical codes are on file with the Clerk of Council for inspection by the public and are on file in the Law Library of Summit County, Ohio, and copies thereof are available from the Clerk for distribution to the public at cost.

Section 5: The Fire Prevention Code is adopted by reference to such technical codes and standards, and are made a part of this Ordinance by incorporation as though fully rewritten herein.

Section 6: Whoever violates any part or provision of the Fire Prevention Code or fails to comply therewith shall be fined not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00). Each day of such offense shall constitute separate offense.

Section 7: Ordinance 57-1973 is repealed.

Section 8: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
