Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Council of the
Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: Council again recognizes the excellence of service
provided by Councilman James Miller.

Section 2: Council again expresses its gratitude to James Miller
for his many contributions to the legislative
process.

Section 3: Council specially commends James Miller for his
unselfish and devoted attention to fill an unexpired
term after having served as a member of Council for
many years.

Section 4: That the Clerk shall spread this Resolution on the
records of this Council and shall post copies thereof
at the appropriate places within the Village as a
fitting testimonial to Councilman Miller and shall
serve upon him a certified copy of this Resolution.

Section 5: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency
measure necessary for the immediate preservation of
the public peace, health, or safety for the reason to
provide a written memorial of service and provided
this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-
thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall
take effect and be in force from and after its
approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect
and be in force from and after the earliest date
provided by law.
