

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES AND MAKING CERTAIN TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS. *As declared an emergency.*

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinance of Richfield, Ohio;

Now Therefore Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Ohio:

Section 1: That the editing, arrangement and numbering of those ordinances and resolutions enacted by Council from January 1, 1979 to July 1, 1984, as listed in the Comparative Section Table, are hereby approved and adopted as printed in the 1984 Replacement Pages subject to technical corrections of Section 2 hereof to the Codified Ordinances so as to achieve uniformity of style and classification. A copy of such Replacement Pages are attached to this Ordinance and incorporated as a part hereof.

Section 2: That the following technical corrections are made to such 1984 Replacement Pages:

On Page 34, Tables of Special Ordinances, Ridgview in place of Ridgeview.

Page 36, Tables of Special Ordinances, Add the following 49-1983 9-6-83 Richfield Township Meeting Room.

Page 36, Tables of Special Ordinances, Add the following 62-1983 12-6-83 Richfield Township Meeting Room.

Page 34, Administrative Code, Substitute the word dental for the word optical in Section 153.02 (c)(5).
