

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE CALCULATION OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD'S RELATIVE NEED IN DETERMINING ITS PROPORTIONATE SHARE OF UNDIVIDED LOCAL GOVERNMENT FUNDS AS SUBMITTED BY THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT BUDGET COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING THE COMPUTATION OF THE RELATIVE NEED TO BE A DETERMINANT IN THE ALLOCATION OF THE UNDIVIDED LOCAL GOVERNMENT FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the County of Summit Budget Commission, Summit County, Ohio has submitted its calculation for the Village of Richfield's relative need in determining its proportionate share of Undivided Local Government Funds, pursuant to an alternate formula, and

WHEREAS, this Council in accordance with the provisions of law has approved the calculation of the relative need of the Village of Richfield to be used as a factor in determining the proportionate share of the Undivided Local Government Funds for the Village of Richfield pursuant to the Alternate formula,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF RICHFIELD, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the percentage heretofore computed as the relative need of the Village of Richfield of Undivided Local Government Funds be ratified and accepted pursuant to the alternate formula, and that said formula is attached as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2. That this alternate formula shall be applied to the distribution of local government funds.

SECTION 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure conducive to the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Richfield in that it is necessary to receive such monies and in order to accomplish the purposes set forth herein. For that reason, provided this resolution shall receive the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise at the earliest date allowed by law.

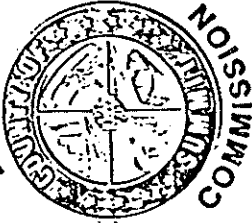

Subject: Allocation of Local Government Funds for 1984

A resolution has been submitted to the County of Summit Council regarding the distribution of local government funds for 1984 as stipulated by the County Budget Commission. The formula to be used in this resolution is the same as was used in 1983 which was percentages of the total available.

A copy of this sample resolution with an attachment noted "Exhibit A" indicating the percentage for each subdivision is enclosed. In order for an alternate formula to be used in 1984, this resolution should be passed by your subdivision's governing body and returned to us by June 20, 1983. This deadline has been established in line with budgetary deadlines in July for Budget Commission's acceptance of subdivision budgets. If a sufficient number of resolutions are not returned by that date to allow for an alternate formula to be used as outlined by statute, we will use the State formula to determine local government allocations for 1984.
