A RESOLUTION RENAMING TOWN PARK IN HONOR OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE OVIATT AND NEWTON FAMILIES

WHEREAS, the land that is currently known as Town Park was donated for public use on April 20, 1841 by Orson Oviatt and his wife Lucretia Oviatt and John Newton and his wife Lara Newton and their families; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to recognize the contribution of the Oviatt and Newton families, which has provided a substantial public asset benefitting the Village of Richfield and its residents, and improving the quality of life in the community; and

WHEREAS, in order to recognize their significant contribution and honor the Oviatt and Newton families, this Council believes it is appropriate to rename Town Park such that it shall henceforth be known as Oviatt - Newton Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Town Park henceforth shall be known as the Oviatt - Newton Park in view of the contribution of land creating the park by the families of Orson and Lucretia Oviatt and John and Lara Newtown.

SECTION 2. That the Village may erect signage, in appropriate locations, reflecting the name and existence of the Oviatt - Newton Park, and may otherwise refer to the Park as such.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
