

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ISSUE DRAFTS FOR THE PAYMENT OF HOSPITALIZATION AND DENTAL EMPLOYEE BENEFITS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Director of Finance have been notified by Aetna Life Insurance Company that the premium for hospitalization and dental employee benefits insurance has been increased by thirty-two percent (32%), and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Ordinances 6-1981 and 47-1983 such coverage forms a part of the compensation of persons employed by this Village and competitive bidding is not required, and

WHEREAS, unless the premium increase is paid the insurance carrier or carriers will cancel the policy and required employee benefits will not be available, and

WHEREAS, the effective date of the increase is October 15, 1983.

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Village of Richfield, Summit County, Ohio:

Section 1: Council finds and determines that authority to the Mayor and Director of Finance is necessary to pay the increase in premium so as to provide required employee coverage.

Section 2: The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized to pay the increased premium required by the existing carrier or carriers of such coverage as are necessary for employee compensation under the provisions of R.C. 731.14.

Section 4: This Ordinance is determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety for the reason to provide required insurance coverage and provided this Ordinance received the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed, it shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date provided by law.
