

A RESOLUTION DECLARING A POLICE DEPARTMENT SERVICE WEAPON SURPLUS PROPERTY, TRANSFERRING OWNERSHIP OF THE SERVICE WEAPON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Officer Robert Gaydosh is scheduled to retire from the Richfield Police Department effective October 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to recognize Officer Gaydosh's service to the Village by presenting him with his service weapon upon his retirement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:

- SECTION 1. Officer Robert Gaydosh's service weapon (Smith & Wesson, M&P, .45 caliber, Serial No. NHA0754 is hereby declared surplus property no longer needed for public use and should be disposed of by transferring ownership of the service weapon to Officer Gaydosh upon his retirement from the Village of Richfield Police Department.
- SECTION 2. Ownership of the Smith & Wesson, M&P, .45 caliber, Serial No. NHA0754 is transferred from the Village of Richfield to Officer Robert Gaydosh upon his retirement from the Village of Richfield Police Department.
- SECTION 3. Transfer of ownership of said service weapon is complete upon the receipt of a release of claims relating to the transfer, possession, and/or use of the service weapon identified above to the Director of Law's satisfaction.
- SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 5. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio and for the further purpose of ensuring that authorization for the transfer of ownership of the service weapon from the Village to Officer Gaydosh occurs as soon as possible upon his retirement; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
