

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF J.S. BOVA EXCAVATING FOR REPAIRS TO THE SANITARY SEWER FORCE MAIN LINE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council previously authorized the Director of Public Service to advertise and solicit bids for repairs to the Village's sanitary sewer force main line; and

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened by the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service recommends that Council accept the bid of J.S. Bova Excavating for \$1,308,860.00 as the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1. Council accepts the bid of J.S. Bova Excavating, 235 State Street, Struthers, Ohio 44471, for \$1,308,860.00 for repairs to the sanitary sewer force main line.

SECTION 2. Council authorizes the Mayor and Finance Director to enter into and execute all necessary contracts with J.S. Bova Excavating, in accordance with the company's bid, and to add a 10% contingency amount to the contract subject to final approval from the Director of Law.

SECTION 3. Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to complete the sanitary sewer force main line repairs as soon as possible; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
