

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE AND SOLICIT BIDS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS AND RELATED EQUIPMENT AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS WITHIN THE VILLAGE, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DIRECTOR OF FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER AS CERTIFIED BY THE VILLAGE ENGINEER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has recommended that Council authorize bids for the installation of traffic signals and related equipment at the intersection of Brecksville Road/W. Streetsboro Road and the intersection of Wheatley Road/Lake Forest Drive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Richfield, County of Summit, State of Ohio that:

- SECTION 1. The Director of Public Service is authorized and directed and solicit bids for the for the installation of traffic signals and related equipment at the intersection of Brecksville Road and W. Streetsboro Road and the intersection of Wheatley Road and Lake Forest Drive in accordance with the specifications prepared by the Village Engineer and on file with the Director of Public Service.
- SECTION 2. The Mayor and Director of Finance are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder as certified by the Village Engineer, provided the bid is within 10% of the Village Engineer's construction estimate, subject to final approval from the Director of Law.
- SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary in order to receive the bids, award the contract, and complete the traffic signal project; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of Council elected or appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
